

BURMAH OIL

FORMAT AND PLAY: The Burmah Oil Competition is an individual Scratch Matchplay event played over 18 holes from the white competition tee markers.

ELEGIBILITY: Entry is open exclusively to men aged 18 or over on 1st April 2026 who meet the handicap criteria outlined below.

Terms of Entry

- The tournament is open to the thirty-two players with the lowest handicaps.
- The four lowest-handicap players will be seeded and placed in positions 1, 32, 16, and 17 in the draw.
- The remaining 28 players will be drawn in groups of seven and allocated to one of the seeded players.
- Players who are cut from the Burmah Oil may enter the Jasper Moon by contacting either the Pro Shop or the Chair of the Competitions Committee, provided they have not already entered. This intention must be declared before the draw is made.

1. Knockout Competitions

1.1 Entry fees for knockout competitions must be paid at the time of entering in the club professional's shop.

1.2 Members entering knockout competitions must be aware of, and available to play on, the set date for Finals Day.

1.3 If, during the knockout schedule, a member becomes unavailable for Finals Day, they must not arrange further matches and must immediately inform the Competitions Committee. The member will be deemed to have withdrawn.

- If withdrawal occurs up to and including the semi-final stage, their opponent will receive a walkover.
- If withdrawal occurs after a semi-final has been played, the losing semi-finalist will take their place in the final.
- Entry fees are non-refundable, regardless of the reason for withdrawal.

Members are expected to make every effort to complete their matches. Withdrawals after entry fall outside the spirit of the game and are discourteous to fellow members.

1.4 If a player qualifies for more than one knockout final, ties will be played over the weekend of the scheduled Finals Day.

1.5 Players are responsible for arranging their matches.

- The first-named player must offer three dates/times to their opponent.
- The opponent must respond within 7 days, either accepting one of the dates or proposing alternatives.
- Once a date/time is agreed, the first-named player must book the tee on BRS and confirm the details.
- If no agreement is reached, the first-named player must notify the Competitions Committee, who will specify a date and time. Both players must then play at that time.
- If the match is still not played by the deadline, the Competitions Committee will determine the outcome based on each player's adherence to the process. The Committee's decision is final.

Members are advised to confirm proposed dates via text or email when arranging matches verbally.

1.6 If a match is tied after 18 holes, a sudden-death play-off will commence from hole 1 until a winner is determined.

1.7 No extensions will be granted beyond the play-by date.

1.8 Players must confirm match results with either the Club Professional or the Chair of Competitions.

FINALS DAY: The final will be played over 36 holes, with referees appointed for each match.

If the match is tied after 36 holes, a sudden-death play-off will be held using holes 1, 2, and 9.

ANNUAL PRESENTATION: This is a Board Competition with prizes awarded for 1st and 2nd place. Prizes will be issued as vouchers redeemable through the Club Professional's shop, with values reviewed annually by the Competitions Committee.

All winners are expected to attend the Presentation Evening. A formal invitation will be sent by the Competitions Committee.

In exceptional circumstances, if a winner cannot attend, they must inform the Captain or the Chair of Competitions and may nominate someone to collect the prize on their behalf.
