



General Rules for all Club Competitions

1. Competitions Committee

- 1.1 All Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf.
- 1.2 The Competition Committee oversee the administration for all competitions.

2. Terms of Entry

- 2.1 Members can enter competitions by using the BRS booking System and selecting their preferred tee time from those allocated.
- 2.2 Members can withdraw without penalty from competition up to 6PM the evening before by removing themselves from their selected tee time within the BRS Booking System
- 2.3 Members booked into playing times for competition by a third party are responsible for ensuring they abide by the General Rules for all Club Competitions.
- 2.4 Entry to Board Competitions will not be permitted outside of the allocated times.
- 2.5 To be eligible to win a board competition, three submitted scores in WHS within the past twelve months are required.
- 2.6 Entry to Medals and Winter Competitions will be permitted outside of the allocated time providing prior agreement is made with either the Pro Shop or the Chair of Competitions
- 2.7 When competitors share a tee time in their competition, scorecards should be exchanged on the first tee before starting the round. Each competitor should ensure his scorecard correctly holds his name, tee time, competition details and entry number.

3. Code of Conduct

- 3.1 Any member who fails to attend their booked time in a competition, or remove their name from BRS without reasonable justification by 6PM the evening before may be subject to the following penalties:
 - a. Upon confirmation from the Competitions Committee a yellow warning will be issued, and this will remain on file for a period of twelve months.
 - b. Upon confirmation from the Competitions Committee any subsequent offence will result in a suspension from all club competitions for a period of fourteen days.
 - c. Any further breaches of the code of conduct may result in further actions being taken under the Llanymynech Golf Club Disciplinary Processes.
- 3.2 General play is not permitted during designated competition tee times.

4. Participation

- 4.1 All competitors must read the rules and format of each competition before they enter.
- 4.2 You will be deemed to have not entered the competition if you have not signed the competition entry sheet.
- 4.3 You will be deemed to have not entered the competition if you do not pay the competition entry fee.

5. Pace Of Play

- 5.1 If you find yourselves out of position as per the guidance below on two consecutive tees you must call the group behind through if they are ready to play.

You are out of position if

- a. You reach the tee of a par three and the group ahead have cleared the next tee.
- b. You reach the tee of a par four and the group ahead have cleared the green.



- c. You reach the tee of a par five and the group ahead are putting out

6. Handicap Allowance

- 6.1 The maximum playing handicap for board competitions for men is 24, for ladies is 36 unless stated in specific competitions rules. E.g. Gross Competitions.
- 6.2 The maximum playing handicap for Monthly Medals, Stableford Competitions and all Non-Board Competitions for both men and ladies Competitions is 54.
- 6.3 For all Open meetings the maximum playing handicap shall be 24 for men and 36 for women. All competitors must have a current competition handicap to qualify for a prize.
