

The Father and Son Cup

TERMS OF ENTRY: The Father and Son Cup is **open exclusively to Father and Son pairings who are members of Llanymynech Golf Club, including juniors. Eligible pairings must consist of a direct biological or legally adopted father–son relationship.** Players may play more than one round, but not with the same partner. To be eligible to win a board competition, each player must have three WHS counting scores within the past 12 months. All entrants must sign in and pay the £5.00 entry fee per pair to the Club Professional or a designated officer on the day of the competition.

FORMAT: The Father and Son Cup is a Greensomes Medal Competition, to be played over 18 holes from the White tee markers, using the White Course slope rating for handicap purposes. In the event of a tie, countback will be employed to determine the winner as follows: the best score for the last 9 holes, followed by the last 6 holes, then the last 3 holes, and finally, the last hole. If the tie persists, it will be resolved based on the last 6 holes of the first 9 holes, then the last 3 holes of the first 9 holes, and lastly, the last hole of the first 9 holes. Should this procedure still fail to separate the tie, a play-off over 18 holes will be arranged at a mutually convenient date and time.

- Both participants commence from the teeing area.
- The players decide which ball they prefer to continue with.
- Players will then play alternate shots until the ball is holed.

Handicap Allowance: **The maximum handicap index is 24.** All competitors are required to have an active handicap within the World Handicap System. The handicap allowance for each partnership is determined by calculating **60% of the lowest exact course handicap** and **40% of the highest exact course handicap**. For this calculation, please refer to the handicap tables available in the pro shop.

MARKERS: When competitors share a tee time in their competition, scorecards should be exchanged on the first tee before starting the round. Each competitor should ensure their scorecard correctly holds their names, tee time, competition details and entry number

PRIZES: This is a Board Competition and there will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd best nett prize. The prizes will be in the format of a voucher which will be redeemable through the Club Professional's shop. The value of prize vouchers will be set and reviewed each year by the competition committee. **All winners are required to attend the presentation evening.** The competition committee will send an official invitation via letter or email to each winner, inviting them to the event. In exceptional circumstances if they are unable to attend, they should inform the Captain or The Chair of Competitions and nominate someone to receive the Prize on their behalf.

CANCELLATION: The Father and Son Cup may be abandoned, cancelled or postponed by the following officials: - Club Professional or Assistant, Greenstaff, Chair of the Competitions Committee or a Member of the Management Committee. This could occur because of adverse weather conditions, or if the course is found to be not fit for purpose, or any other unforeseen circumstances. In any case, the Committee will endeavour to re-schedule the event, if the busy fixture list allows.

THE SCORECARD: All pairs must record their scores on the Club's official scorecard, which must be **signed by both the marker and the player.** Scorecards must be fully checked and deposited in the scorecard box located beneath the PSI **within 30 minutes of completing your round.** Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the competition.

The act of returning your scorecard is deemed to be your final submission. Once submitted, no amendments can be made. Any scorecard or Competition queries affecting the scorecard must be raised with a club official within the 30-minute period specified above.

THE COMPETITION RESULT: The results of The Father and Son Cup become final upon their publication via the Club Website.
