

THE NORMAN RADFORD TANKARD

TERMS OF ENTRY: Male members of Llanymynech Golf Club, **not including juniors**, can enter via BRS where an adequate number of tee times will be made available on the competition date. By booking a tee time within BRS you are committing to play in The Norman Radford Tankard but If you find you are unable to play after the draw is made then you must inform the Competitions Committee and where possible find a replacement of a similar handicap. Failure to inform the Competitions Committee will result in further action being taken as set out in the Code of Conduct of the General Rules for all Club Competitions. **To win a board competition, participants need three WHS submitted scores within the past year.** All entrants must sign in and pay a £5.00 entry fee per pair to the club professional or a designated officer on the day of the competition.

FORMAT: The Norman Radford Tankard is a 4 ball better ball Medal Competition, to be played over 18 holes from the White tee markers, using the White Course slope rating for handicap purposes. This is a board competition and is High/Low draw for partners. The draw will be made by the Competitions Committee in the week of the Competition. The current handicaps of the competitors, at the time of the draw, will determine the cut-off point between High and Low. In the event of a tie, countback will be employed to determine the winner as follows: the best score for the last 9 holes, followed by the last 6 holes, then the last 3 holes, and finally, the last hole. If the tie persists, it will be resolved based on the last 6 holes of the first 9 holes, then the last 3 holes of the first 9 holes, and lastly, the last hole of the first 9 holes. Should this procedure still fail to separate the tie, a play-off over 18 holes will be arranged at a mutually convenient date and time at Llanymynech Golf Club

HANDICAP ALLOWANCE: The handicap allowance is set at **85% of the exact course handicap**, with a **maximum playing handicap of 24**. All participants are required to have an active handicap within the World Handicap System.

MARKERS: When competitors share a tee time in their competition, scorecards should be exchanged on the first tee before starting the round. Each competitor should ensure his scorecard correctly holds his name, tee time, competition details and entry number

PRIZES: This is a Board Competition and there will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd best Nett score prize. The prizes will be in the format of a voucher which will be redeemable through the Club Professional's shop. The value of prize vouchers will be set and reviewed each year by the competition committee. **All winners are required to attend the presentation evening.** The competition committee will send an official invitation via letter or email to each winner, inviting them to the event. In exceptional circumstances if they are unable to attend, they should inform the Captain or The Chair of Competitions and nominate someone to receive the Prize on their behalf.

CANCELLATION: The Norman Radford Tankard may be abandoned, cancelled or postponed by the following officials: - Chair of the Competitions Committee or a Member of the Management Committee. This could occur because of adverse weather conditions, or if the course is found to be not fit for purpose, or any other unforeseen circumstances. In any case, the Committee will endeavour to re-schedule the event, if the busy fixture list allows.

THE SCORECARD: All pairs must record their scores on the Club's official scorecard, which must be **signed by both the marker and the player**. Scorecards must be fully checked and deposited in the scorecard box located beneath the PSI **within 30 minutes of completing your round**. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the competition.

The act of returning your scorecard is deemed to be your final submission. Once submitted, no amendments can be made. Any scorecard or Competition queries affecting the scorecard must be raised with a club official in person at the club or by email or text within the 30-minute period specified above.

THE COMPETITION RESULT: The results of The Norman Radford Tankard become final upon their publication the Club Website
