

THE PARKER LEIGHTON CUP

TERMS OF ENTRY: Members of Llanymynech Golf Club, **including juniors**, can enter The Parker Leighton Cup through the BRS Booking system. Two juniors are NOT allowed to play in the same pairing, and it is a recommendation of the competition committee that juniors refrain from playing with another family member. **To win a board competition, participants need three WHS submitted scores within the past year.** All entrants must sign in and pay a £5.00 entry fee per pair to the club professional or a designated officer on the day of the competition.

FORMAT AND TIES: The Parker Leighton Cup is a **Mixed Greensomes Medal Competition, men will play from the purple course and ladies will the red course. The Red Course will be used to determine pars and stroke index.** In the event of a tie, countback will be employed to determine the winner as follows: the best score for the last 9 holes, followed by the last 6 holes, then the last 3 holes, and finally, the last hole. If the tie persists, it will be resolved based on the last 6 holes of the first 9 holes, then the last 3 holes of the first 9 holes, and lastly, the last hole of the first 9 holes. Should this procedure still fail to separate the tie, a play-off over 18 holes will be arranged at a mutually convenient date and time at Llanymynech Golf Club

- Both participants commence from the teeing area.
- The players decide which ball they prefer to continue with.
- Players will then play alternate shots until the ball is holed.

HANDICAP ALLOWANCE: **The maximum handicap index will be 24 for men and 36 for ladies.** The handicap allowance for each partnership is calculated as follows: **60% of the lowest course handicap and 40% of the highest course handicap. The Red Course will be used to determine pars and stroke index.**

MARKERS: When competitors share a tee time in their competition, scorecards should be exchanged on the first tee before starting the round. Each pair should ensure their scorecard correctly holds their names, handicaps, tee time, competition details and entry number

PRIZES: This is a Board Competition and there will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd best Nett score prize. The prizes will be in the format of a voucher which will be redeemable through the Club Professional's shop. The value of prize vouchers will be set and reviewed each year by the competition committee. **All winners are required to attend the presentation evening.** The competition committee will send an official invitation via letter or email to each winner, inviting them to the event. In exceptional circumstances if they are unable to attend, they should inform the Captain or The Chair of Competitions and nominate someone to receive the Prize on their behalf.

CANCELLATION: The Parker Leighton Cup may be abandoned, cancelled or postponed by the following officials: - Chair of the Competitions Committee or a Member of the Management Committee. This could occur because of adverse weather conditions, or if the course is found to be not fit for purpose, or any other unforeseen circumstances. In any case, the Committee will endeavour to re-schedule the event, if the busy fixture list allows.

THE SCORECARD: All pairs must record their scores on the Club's official scorecard, which must be **signed by both the marker and the player.** Scorecards must be fully checked and deposited in the scorecard box located beneath the PSI **within 30 minutes of completing your round.** Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the competition.

The act of returning your scorecard is deemed to be your final submission. Once submitted, no amendments can be made. Any scorecard or Competition queries affecting the scorecard must be raised with a club official in person at the club or by email or text within the 30-minute period specified above.

THE COMPETITION RESULT: The results of The Parker Leighton Cup become final upon their publication Via The Club Website
